This medal has been awarded on very few occasions by the national sailing authority in the United States, and it is indeed an honor to receive it.

We confirm our telephone conversation that Capt. Vogiatzis is due in your office within the next week or so, and that you will present the award to him. As I suggested to you, I believe it would be very appropriate to take a photograph of the presentation of the medal to the captain. I would appreciate print being sent to M. Jacqueline Rees, Director of Information at the U.K. Club, who is receiving copy of this letter, and to me, so that I can forward same to US SAILING, who may publish it in their magazine.

As a sailor I often find myself in international waters, and it is indeed comforting to know that there are still seamen who perform their duties of lookout in such an admirable fashion as did the captain and crew of the M/V PEARL on January 13, 1997 when they rescued the PEREGRINES crew in the Gulf of Mexico.

The Arthur B. Hanson Rescue Award was awarded to Capt. Stamatios Vogiatzis and Crew of M/V PEARL
