Cruise from Charlevoix to Beaver Island, 16 kts. 5' seas.

Richard and Fran Corrington were sailing a Catalina 25' when a large wave hit the boat, causing Richard to fall overboard under the single life line. Fran threw him the Lifesling, lowered the sails and pulled him next to the boat so she could winch him in with the main halyard. At the same time, Lee Cobb and Tom Burzyck were passing on a commercial ferry and saw what was happening. They jumped into the water to assist Fran in getting her husband back on board. First aid was administered and Richard was taken to a hospital where he was treated for hypothermia and shock, but later released with no complications.

The Arthur B. Hanson Rescue Medal was presented to Fran Corrington, Lee Cobb and Tom Burzyck as a result of this event.
