US SAILING Association Board of Directors' Meeting Minutes Tuesday, December 19, 2006 Teleconference

1. Call to Order.

• President Capron called the Board of Directors meeting to Order at 8:00 pm Eastern Time Zone

2. Roll.

• Secretary Hagedorn called the roll.

3. Actions Between Meetings

A MOTION to approve the minutes of the November 19, 2006 Meeting of the Board of Directors was approved via electronic voting on December 4, 2006.

5. Executive Director's Report

Executive Director Leighton reviewed the financial performance of the organization both in total and by department. With two weeks to go in the year, the staff forecasts a \$192,500 year end surplus. Leighton said he is in the process of providing all Directors with performance assessments for their leadership, business acumen, and interpersonal skills. The Directors were also asked to assess themselves to add to the richness of the discussion. Looking forward, each of the Staff Directors has been asked to provide the Executive Director with a page of ideas on how US SAILING can generate new revenue and create value for our members. As an outgrowth of the discussion it was agreed that the Board would have a detailed discussion on borrowing practices and needs at our face-to-face meeting on February 17, 2006 along with the association's month by month experiences in 2005 and 2006.

6. Treasurer's Report

Treasurer Keller had no formal report to provide the Board beyond that included in the Executive Director's Report and is confident in our financial position as presented.

7. 2007 Budget

Budget Chair Appel and Executive Director Leighton led a discussion of the FY 2007 Budget. The budget includes no major changes or additions to the 2006 programs except website support, and provides for a \$68,663 surplus at year end. Added challenges in 2007 as compared to 2006 include \$21,000 to cover a \$0.02 increase in postage; a \$60,000 increase in IT staff salaries for web support; and recognition that without the Bermuda Race (\$50,000) and the fact that we are in the 3rd year of the rulebook quad (\$19,000) our revenues will be lower.

Dean Brenner gave an overview of the Olympic Budget to the Board, explaining that all of the \$2,503,800 in expenses is covered by cash that is on hand, already pledged for 2007 or from USOC and our family of corporate sponsors. These expenditures, combined with another \$650,000 in off-budget direct grants from the USOC, create the \$3.1 million that will be spent in 2007 with over 85% going to athletes and athlete support. The Board also discussed the fact that ZERO monies from US SAILING Membership revenues are invested in the Olympic Sailing Program. This last point is not always remembered by our members, and in 2007 the USOC has reduced its investment in our program for the express reason that US SAILING does not invest any dollars in its Olympic Program – an action that the USOC has warned of in the past and is, for the first time, actually doing.

The US Paralympic Committee has not finalized its grants to the OSC. Once those are realized, an expense plan that balances with the revenue will be created. This will result in no impact on the bottom line of either the Olympic Department or the Association.

In addition, it was noted that the Budget does not incorporate the impact of new Regulation 8.06.E and is instead using historical data for the ISAF Delegation expenses. The new 2006 regulation significantly changed the per diem costs for travel to non-U.S. destinations even though no change was intended. The Board's Bylaws and Regulations Working Party will be submitting a proposal to revert to the 2005 language.

MOTION: It was moved, seconded and approved to accept the 2007 Budget as presented.

Budget Chair Appel excused himself from the call after the vote at 9:10 pm Eastern Time Zone.

8. President's Report

President Capron referred to his written report. Of particular interest is the on-going IT initiative started in late 2005. Earlier this month, several staff members and volunteers met by conference call to discuss the database upgrade project, the website and the state of IT at US SAILING. The new membership database will provide staff and volunteers much improved access, but the value will depend on the quality of the data. Capron said that the collection and maintenance of key data should be a priority for both staff and volunteers.

President Capron also asked the Board's opinion about his accepting invitations for international judging and umpiring – the concerted opinion of the Board was that he should accept those that he could as it furthered our position as an association on the international stage.

8. Olympic Report

Dean Brenner allowed that his presentation during the Budget discussion fulfilled his report.

9. February 17, 2006 Board Meeting in Marina del Rey

The meeting will be held at the California Yacht Club, with thanks to Bill Stump. Bill will send information to the Board about potential housing options. All are asked to share their itineraries with Bill so that the start time can be finalized and it can be determined if rides from the airport will be available.

10. Safety At Sea Committee submissions

At the November meetings of the Safety At Sea Committee, two prescriptions were proposed to the Board of Directors to effectively delay the impact of two ISAF Special Regulations (3.03.1.c and 3.08.2.a). Action was deferred to the January, 29, 2007, meeting of the Board of Directors, on these recommendations pending more information. Bill Stump will coordinate the compilation.

- b. Update on Council Bylaws and Committee Terms of Reference
 - i. Patty Lawrence reported that the final three (3) sets of Council Bylaws (ISSA, Coaches and Instructors, and Industry) should be ready for presentation in January 2007. It was noted that there were a few grammatical and editorial opportunities in the two sets of Bylaws that were approved this evening and it was agreed that non-substantive changes should be accomplished by Lawrence and the appropriate Council.
 - ii. It was announced that President Capron with Secretary Hagedorn and Patty Lawrence will work with the Division Chairs to collect Terms of Reference for all of the 53 US SAILING Committees for subsequent approval by the Board.

12. New Business

a. Regulation 8.07 was discussed since the 2006 suspension of this regulation expires at the end of this month. The regulation may have outgrown its usefulness, given our expected surplus at the end of FY 2006. It was decided that the regulation should be reviewed and openly discussed at the Spring Meeting with other proposed changes to the Bylaws and Regulations.

MOTION: It was moved, seconded and approved that the 2006 suspension of Regulation 8.07 be extended for the months of January and February, 2007, pending finalization of the FY 2006 year-end surplus and an open discussion at the March Spring Meeting of the necessity and value of retaining this regulation.

 b. Susan Epstein reported on the activities of the Board's Bylaw/Regulation Review Working Party. To date, there are 20 probable changes to the Bylaws and at least 9 to the Regulations. The Working Party plans to have the changes ready for initial Board review in January so that they may go to the Bylaws committee and the House of Delegates before final action by the Board during the Spring Meeting in March.

13. Executive Session

The Board went into Executive Session at 9:30 pm Eastern Time and Executive Director Leighton excused himself at that time.

14. Adjournment

A Motion to Adjourn was made, seconded and approved at 9:40 pm Eastern Time Zone.
