- 4) The Board met to learn and discuss the many implications surrounding the recent USOC Hearing Panel decision, especially in light of the fact that there may be a short window in which to appeal the decision of the Hearing Panel.

President Capron led a discussion on the scope of the impact that the USOC Hearing Panel decision will have on the sport, and the extent of the changes that would be needed in the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing as a result. After significant discussion it was agreed that the US SAILING President and the USOC AAC Sailing Representative, Carol Cronin, should travel to Colorado Springs to meet with the USOC staff to share the steps needed to bring the ISAF rules in compliance with the Hearing Panel's decision, and the implications of having to change that many rules of the International Federation.
