Most students require at least two sessions per level prior to advancing. Everyone receives an award to publically display his/her achievement.



1 - Green - SeaSteward

Sailing

SeaStewards are "green" beginners introduced to the power of the wind and basic sailing skills. Students learn safety, nomenclature, rigging, sail handling, and steering a course.
