This also includes encouraging the hosting and creation of development events which ultimately lead to participation in the US Team Racing Championship. We propose that the US Team Racing Championship be a Sub-Committee under the team Racing Committee

**Subject:** Youth Instructional App Development

**Action Requested** (word this in resolution form):

So it be resolved, US Sailing Youth Department requests approval to allocate \$50,000 from the Gamble Fund to fund the development and launch of a mobile App for youth education, instruction and skills tracking.

The proposed App will be the tool by which US Sailing's Youth Department implements the concepts of the Youth Development Model, cultivating the next generation of lifelong sailors in a variety of sailing disciplines, both racing and non-racing. The Youth Development Model has been shared with members at national and regional events and in the *American Sailor* newsletter, and the App is the tool that will empower programs of any size to implement these concepts at the local level.

The App is an instructional tool that connects sailors, parents, and instructors with cutting edge content from US Sailing's education experts. Instructors will have access to US Sailing curricula, including skill and drill demonstration videos and lesson plans featuring instructional games, drills, and activities. Instructors can use the App to communicate with their program's sailors and parents to share practice activities, constructive feedback, and skill assessments and badges.

The App will be built for US Sailing by New Start Mobile. New Start Mobile ("New Start") will bring to this engagement and relationship with US Sailing a unique blend of experience in both working with national governing sports bodies in delivering technology for their coaching and education efforts, and the capabilities and resources of a comprehensive and contemporary software house. New Start has successfully partnered with other high profile clients in the sport association vertical including the US Olympic Committee, the Canadian Olympic Committee, the International Olympic Committee, the US Golf Association, US Lacrosse, the US Tennis Association, USA Field Hockey, USA Baseball, USA Ultimate (Frisbee) and USA Hockey. New Start has worked closely with several of these associations as they develop and update their USOC American Development Model policies, practices and platforms.

**Member Impacts:** Describe below the impacts (i.e. Will it be seen as a member benefit or not? Explain) Any perceived positive effects:

The youth instructional App will be an important new benefit to our members, including youth sailors, instructors, parent and Local Sailing Organizations.

- Fingertip access to educational content will help programs and instructors teach to the US Sailing standard in a fun, engaging way.
- Parents of youth sailors will receive ongoing, high quality feedback about their sailor's progress in the sport, and resources to guide them to the next steps in sailing.
- Youth sailors will have more frequent and substantive engagement with US Sailing.
- Premium content can be offered as an "in-App purchase", offering additional revenue.



- The App may also be an attractive new platform for US Sailing sponsors.

Any perceived negative effects:

- Over time, print publication sales may decrease as more content is available digitally.

Will this proposal bring in new members?

Yes. Access to the majority of App features will be a member benefit, verified by a Single-Sign-On process in the App. Instructors will need to keep their membership and certification up to date in order to maintain access, and youth sailors and their parents will join US Sailing in order to gain access to instructor feedback, progress tracking, helpful content and the video library.

**Mission Impacts:** Describe below how and why this creates value.

Positive impact (be specific):

- Along with membership and revenue growth, the instructional App will improve the quality of sailing instruction by offering US Sailing's best education material in an accessible, mobile format.
- Frequent communication and engagement with instructors, sailors, parents, and programs will allow US Sailing to be the connection point for youth sailing education.
- User data will offer a valuable new insight into youth sailing participation statistics, including skill levels, retention, instructor and program effectiveness, etc. This data will help sailing programs improve at the local level and guide US Sailing's efforts at the national level. It can also be leveraged for targeted marketing and communications purposes.

**Financial Impacts:** Describe below any expected financial impacts on US Sailing. Include figures.

Positive effects:

The App will add a powerful new element to our youth membership value proposition. Currently, youth membership is only necessary for participation in Junior Olympic Sailing Festivals and US Sailing Championships. By appealing to a broader audience of sailors and parents, the youth membership will be positioned for long-term growth in a much broader market of sailing students.

The revenue forecast, including the number of new members generated as well as revenue from in-App purchases, will be finalized in December 2018, after staff members of the Youth, Education, and IT Departments meet with New Start Mobile on December 3<sup>rd</sup>. Coming out of this meeting, we will have a timeline for App features that will be available in 2019, and those that will not be developed until 2020.

The preferred roll-out strategy in 2019 will be to market directly to sailing programs, as an instructional tool for their instructors and sailing students. Based on an estimate of 50 new members per program, membership fees would generate approximately \$1,200 per program.



Three year revenue outlook:

Negative effects:

Investment needed for initial development and launch:

App Development w/ New Start Mobile: \$30,000

Adaptation of existing instructional content to App: \$10,000

Development of new instructional content (including video): \$10,000

Total: \$50,000

After initial development, the ongoing hosting costs with New Start Mobile will be less than \$10,000 per year regardless of the number of users. This, and the cost of development of new features after initial launch, will be funded through program revenue.

**Summary:**

The youth instructional App will be a new tool for building future generations of lifelong sailors. By modernizing sailing instruction with mobile technology, instructors will be more engaged and effective. The curricula is based on standards set by US Sailing experts, and the pathways lead to lifelong sailing across all sailing disciplines. Programs that take full advantage of this technology will set a new standard for youth instruction, and young sailors will stay engaged with US Sailing as they progress.
