Sailing Instructions Amendment #1

SI 1.7 is changed to:

"The notation. [DP] in an instruction in these Sailing Instructions means that the penalty for a breach of that instruction may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification and may range from a reprimand to a dismissal from the regatta."

SI 9.1 is changed to:

"Marks 1, 2, 3s, 3p will be red cones. Mark 1A will be a yellow tetrahedron. The offset mark will be a small yellow tetrahedron."

SI 9.2 is changed to:

"New marks, when used as described in SI 11, will be:
Mark 1 – orange tetrahedron
Mark 1a – orange tetrahedron with black cap."

SI 11 is amended to add:

"In case of a change, the offset mark will not be moved."

SI 24.1 is changed to:

"US Sailing Championship medals will be awarded to competitors who finish first through fifth in each fleet."

SI 24.2 is changed to:

"Prizes will be awarded to competitors finishing in the top three (3) places in each fleet."

SI 24.3 is changed to:

"The Ida Lewis Trophy is the perpetual trophy presented to the winning team of the Club 420 fleet. The Ida Lewis Trophy remains on permanent display at the Ida Lewis Yacht Club in Newport, RI."
