6 WORLD SAILING REGULATIONS

- 6.1 Each competitor, boat owner and *support person* shall comply with the World Sailing Regulations that have been designated by World Sailing as having the status of a *rule*. These regulations as of 30 June 2020 are the World Sailing:
 - Advertising Code
 - Anti-Doping Code
 - Betting and Anti-Corruption Code
 - Disciplinary Code
 - Eligibility Code
 - Sailor Categorization Code
- Rule 63.1 does not apply unless *protests* are permitted in the Regulation alleged to have been broken.

2017-2020 Edition

Not included in prior edition. Combines previous rules 5, 6 and 7 and includes three additional World Sailing Regulations previously found in definition of *Rule*.

Comments from *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024* Study Version

- The wording of the last line of [6.1 introduction] paragraph has been edited for ease of reading. The date has been changed to the last day on which the 2021 draft RRS can be changed.
- In all six bullet points, the word 'Code' has been added to reflect the fact that the title of each of the regulations listed here ends with the word 'Code'. These additions will make it a bit easier for a reader to locate one of these regulations in the lengthy World Sailing Regulations.
- The wording of the last bullet point is the result of Submission 112-19, Proposal 2.
- The changes in rules 5, 6 and 7 are the result of Submission 143-19, as edited. On 22 June, rule 6.2 was reworded for clarity.
