# **DESIGNATED ADULT**

All competitors must have a "Designated Adult" with you at the event acting as a chaperone. Your Designated Adult must be present at the onsite registration. This Designated Adult must be over 21 and cannot be a coach.

#### **MEALS**

All competitors, as part of your registration fee will be served breakfast, lunch and dinners by Camp Sea Gull.

#### **HOUSING**

Sailors are responsible for securing their own housing for the event. There will be a **2200 curfew** during the event, meaning all competitors must have returned to their accommodations by this time each night. These regulations are in effect from registration day, October 8<sup>th</sup> through the duration of the event on October 11<sup>th</sup>.

Our open-air cabins sleep up to 10 people. Each cabin has large, screened windows that open to let the river breezes come through, a charcoal grill and a large bathroom area including sinks and private bathrooms. # **Pricing and payment**

Pricing below is per person and includes all lodging, meals and all activities are included for the entire weekend. (Check-in time is 3:00pm; check-out time is Monday at 5:00 p.m.)

  - Regatta Sailors & Coaches: \$250 / person
  - Event attendees: \$400 / person
    A \$50 per-person deposit is due today\*
- Check in on Friday
  - Regatta Sailors & Coaches: \$186.50 / person
  - Event attendees: \$300 / person
    A \$50 per-person deposit is due today\*

All individuals on your registration today will be housed together in the same cabin. If you would like to share a cabin with individuals from another registration, you can note this on your reservation. Housing requests MUST be mutual.

\*Per person deposits are non-refundable. The final balance will be drafted from the credit card used for your deposit today on **September 9**. If you register on or after September 9, your final balance will be drafted from the card used today within 3-5 business days.

#### **ACCESS TO CAMP SEA GULL**

All sailors, coaches, parents, family members and volunteers must register with Camp Sea Gull to access the property. For those staying on site this is a part of your housing registration. Anyone staying offsite will need to register through this link

If you choose to stay in a hotel or rental house instead of staying onsite at the event venue, you can still choose a Meal Plan and Activity Passes. Choose from an All Access pass that will cover you for the whole weekend, or choose single day passes for a portion of the event.

If you are coming to watch as a spectator, admission is free, but an entry pass <u>is required</u> to enter the venue.

We encourage all attendees to pre-purchase our event passes. For safety and planning, a limited number of event passes will be available each day for a premium on a first-come, first-serve basis.

# **Pricing and payment**

Pricing listed below is per person. All Event Access Passes are due in full today. Your meal and activity tickets will be available for you at check-in.

- All Access Pass: \$40 or \$80 per person\*
  - All meals and activities starting Fri. 10/8 through Mon. 10/11 along with Sunday's Celebration Dinner are included.
    - \*Regatta Sailors and Coaches receive a reduced rate for All Access Passes.
- Single Day Access Pass: \$25 per person/ day
  - Just visiting for the day and want to participate in all that the host site has to offer?
    You can purchase one or more access passes for a single day. An Access Pass for Sunday will include our Celebration Dinner.
- Spectator Only Entry Pass: Free
  - Admission is free, but an entry pass is required for all guests. Reserve your pass for each day and enjoy an express check-in when you arrive. Our Celebration Dinner on Sunday evening can be purchased for an additional \$15/ person.





# ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

All competitors must arrange their own transportation from arrival airport to Camp Sea Gull. Camp Sea Gull is offering transportation from Coastal Carolina Regional Airport to Camp Sea Gull on Thursday, October 7<sup>th</sup> and return to the airport on Monday October 11<sup>th</sup>. #### **EVENT TRAILER PARKING**

Competitor parking, trailer parking instructions and maps will be provided at onsite registration. During the designated arrival times Camp Sea Gull will have volunteer parking staff on site assisting arriving families. Large, multi-boat trailers should contact Andrew Crook (Andrew.crook@seagull-seafarer.org) to pre-arrange arrival time. We request all multi-boat trailers arrive Thursday, October 7th due to the complexities of unloading and parking prior to all other arrivals on Friday, October 8.

#### **AWARDS CEREMONY AND DEPARTURES**

The awards ceremony on Monday, October 11th is mandatory for all competitors. Please keep in mind, competitors will not be allowed to leave before the Awards Ceremony. Any deviations require prior approval by Boo Carraway (boo.carraway@wrightsvillebch.com), National Chair. Permission will only be granted for extenuating circumstances.

#### **ONSITE CHECK-IN AND REGISTRATION**

Registration will be open on Friday October 8 at 1000 – 1800 hours on the porch of Cheek Hall. Early arrivals to Camp Sea Gull (prior to October 7<sup>th</sup>) are not permitted, and there will be no exceptions to this rule. Upon arrival at Camp Sea Gull, please proceed directly to Cheek Hall where the registration team will review and ensure all information has been correctly submitted and received. Please ensure you have a designated adult with you at registration.





Your lifejacket will be inspected at registration. You must wear a USCG approved PFD that is the right size for your weight and is 100% dependent on foam for flotation. Please refer to the NOR for requirements. Note: PFD's with patches, holes or tears are not USCG legal.

Competitors will be expected to install the provided bow stickers and sail top numbers following registration. Competitors' sails must be numbered in accordance with class rules. Country code is not required.

# **COACHING**

US Sailing provides a staff of fleet coaches for each fleet that is available to all sailors. US Sailing provided coaches will be conducting an optional practice on Registration Day from 1200 – 1700.

#### **PRIVATE COACHING**

Private coaching is permitted at this event. If you will be working with a private coach, please share this important information with them.

Private coaches must hold up-to-date US Sailing Level 1 Instructor certification (interim policy) and must register via the link below by October 1st. (International coaches who hold a non-US Sailing coaching certification must contact US Sailing to confirm the validity of their certification at <a href="mailto:championships@ussailing.org">championships@ussailing.org</a> and must be US Sailing members).

Private coaches attending the Championship are required to have completed SafeSport training and hold a valid background check certification.

SafeSport: To check your SafeSport training status, log into My US Sailing – up to date status of SafeSport training is on the "Certifications" list for each member. If you need to complete the training for the first time, <u>click here</u>

Background check: Upon registration, an e-mail will be sent to each private coach who needs to complete a background check prompting them to fill out their information so that the background check can be completed. Background checks must be completed (and passed!) before the event. Note: it takes about 2 weeks for a background check to be completed.

Private coaches must bring their own coach boat and equipment. Camp Sea Gull has 13' boats for charter for private coaches only, please contact <a href="Morgan.stephens@seagull-seafarer.org">Morgan.stephens@seagull-seafarer.org</a>

Private coaches must register via the below link by October 1<sup>st</sup>. Private coach registration fee is \$275 and includes all meals, and coach boat berthing.

#### **SPECTATOR BOATS**

Camp Sea Gull will offer at least one spectator boat per racing course. Private spectator boats will be permitted and must abide by all rules and regulations as stated in US Sailing's Support Boat Policy and the Sailing Instructions. Private spectator boats may dock at Camp Seafarer facilities overnight if arranged in advance for \$50. #### **SAFETY MESSAGE**

# **Current US Sailing COVID-19 Policy**

US Sailing allows individuals to travel, and attend, any US Sailing Event/seminar provided they meet the following quidelines. Please ensure that you follow the quidelines that best describe you:

# <u>People who are fully vaccinated with an FDA-authorized vaccine or a vaccine authorized for emergency use by the World Health Organization</u>

Any individual who is fully vaccinated is not required to be tested prior to attending a US Sailing sanctioned event but must be able to show proof of vaccination upon request. In general, people are considered fully vaccinated:

2 weeks after their second dose in a 2-dose series, such as the Pfizer or Moderna vaccines, or

2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine, such as Johnson & Johnson's Janssen vaccine

# People who are not fully vaccinated

People who are not fully vaccinated must take the following steps to protect themselves and others:

# Before travel:

• Get tested with a viral test 1-3 days before the trip. You must be able to show proof of a negative test upon request.

#### While traveling:

- Wear a mask over your nose and mouth. Masks are required on planes, buses, trains, and other forms of public transportation traveling into, within, or out of the United States and in U.S. transportation hubs such as airports and stations.
- Avoid crowds and stay at least 6 feet/2 meters (about 2 arm lengths) from anyone who is not traveling with them.
- Wash hands often or use hand sanitizer (with at least 60% alcohol).

#### People who were infected more than 10 days ago, but less than 180.

People with evidence of a COVID infection are not required to retest for 180 days from the infection onset. An example of evidence would be a doctor's note. Individuals must be able to show proof of meeting this criterion upon request.

# One-on-One Abuse Prevention Policies

For the duration of any US Sailing Championship event, all adults participating in the event as coaches, race officers, event organizers, medical staff, and volunteers shall adhere to the following one-on-oneabuse prevention policies.

One-on-One Interactions Between Adults and Unrelated Minor Competitors	General Rule: While on-site at a US Sailing Youth Championship event, all one-on-one contact between an adult and unrelated minor competitormust be observable and interruptible.
Meetings and Training Sessions	All individual, one-on-one meetings and training sessions between an adult and an unrelated minorcompetitor must take place in an area that is observable and interruptible.
Athletic Training Sessions, Massages, Rubdowns	All individual, one-on-one athletic training sessions, massages, and rubdowns involving an adult and unrelated minor competitor must be: Observable and interruptible, Performed with another adult present, and Have prior written consent from the minor's parent/guardian.
Locker Rooms & Changing Areas	Adults may not have unobservable and uninterruptible contact with an unrelated minor competitor in any locker room or changing area.





Media & Electronic Communications	All one-on-one electronic communications between an adult coach, volunteer, or regatta official and unrelated minor competitor must be open and transparent. Open and transparent means that an adult shall copy or include on any electronic communication with a minor competitor: The minor competitor's parent/guardian or other adult family member, or Another adult (such as a coach).
	Team Communications: All electronic team communications with minor competitors shall include at least two adults.
Transportation	An adult shall not transport a minor competitor one-on-one to/from the event site unless that adulthas prior, written consent from the minor competitor's parent/guardian.
Lodging	No minor competitor may stay overnight in the same room with an unrelated adult chaperone without prior written consent from the minor competitor's parent/guardian.
