V. CFO Report

Heather Monoson, CFO, walked through the preliminary 2020 year-end financials. She shared we ended the year with a solid revenue of 840k. This strong performance is associated with 500k booked in pledge support. Additionally, our cash flow position is healthy with a burn-rate of 8 months cash reserve on hand. She additionally shared she would like to always have a 6-9 month reserve on hand and as we get stronger footing this would increase. Lastly, she thanked all the employees at US Sailing for their hard work to keep the organization financially stable.

John Schoendorf shared that the detailed financial statement for year-end will be sent when they are completed. Additionally, he gave kudos to Heather and her team for the new credit card expense approval system.
