

## SafeSport Guidelines: Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy

One-on-One Interactions	<ul> <li>Private one-one-one interactions are not allowed.</li> </ul>
	All interaction should occur at a distance
	that is observable and interruptible by
	another adult.
Locker Rooms & Changing Areas	Recording devices in locker room &
	changing areas prohibited.
	<ul> <li>Coaches shall not be alone with an athlete</li> <li>in these space (refer to the one on one)</li> </ul>
	in these areas (refer to the one-on-one
Media & Electronic Communications	<ul> <li>policy).</li> <li>All electronic communications shall be</li> </ul>
	professional in nature and between the
	hours of 8am-8pm.
	<ul> <li>Always copy another adult (coach or parent</li> </ul>
	of a minor(s)) when communicating
	electronically with minor athletes.
	• It is recommended that adults do not
	maintain private social media connections
	with unrelated minors.
Travel Guidelines	<ul> <li>Coaches shall not ride in a vehicle alone</li> </ul>
	with a minor.
	Adults shall not share a hotel room or other
	sleeping arrangements with an unrelated
	minor athlete without the express, written
	permission of the minor athlete's parent or guardian.
	<ul> <li>If/When doing room checks, attending</li> </ul>
	team meeting or other activities, two
	adults should be present.
	<ul> <li>Meetings should not be conducted in hotel</li> </ul>
	rooms.
	• If disciplinary action against a participant is
	required while the participant is traveling
	with his or her parents, the Parent will be
	notified before any action is taken, except
	when immediate action is necessary and,
	then as soon as possible thereafter
