

### **Phase 2 Sailing Skills**

Focus Skill - the topic I am practicing

**Cues-** Helpful words for you to remember when practicing this skill.

Steering with Rudder

Prepare - Properly adjust your body position, tiller hand, and mainsheet hand.

Steer - Use the tiller or tiller extension to turn the boat to port and back to starboard.

Avoid Collisions - Move the "Tiller Towards Trouble," using just the tiller you can steer away from trouble.
