

From train station, line 13, bus stop “Lorient Gare SNCF” to “LORIENT La Base – Cité de la Voile”.




From downtown , line T2, direction “LORIENT La Base – Cité de la Voile”


- This contract will also set out the terms and conditions for payment of the deposit:

DISTRESS BEACONS:

- All additional personal AIS beacons and PLBs which are on board for the race must be officially registered as quickly as possible with the Organiser and with the correct emergency phone number for the RaceDirector.
- Proof of this registration and the hexadecimal code for the beacons must be emailed to: odhwc@lorientgrandlarge.org
- Safety equipment checks will be carried out on all the boats in Lorient together with any seals if necessary.
- 1 engine seals will be distributed for each race. Details will be given during first briefing
