

Certificates: International Offshore Safety at Sea course with Hands-on Training

Attendees who complete the prerequisites and hands-on training will receive a World Sailing-compliant US Sailing Sanctioned International Offshore Safety at Sea with hands-on training Certificate.

Prerequisites

First-time certificates:

Complete the Online Safety at Sea Offshore Course (units 1-15) before taking a hands-on (1-day) course. The Safety at Sea Offshore certificate **must be dated within 365 days of taking the hands-on course.**

or

Take a one-day in-person US Sailing Sanctioned Offshore Safety at Sea Course and then take the hands-on course. The Safety at Sea Offshore certificate **must be dated within 365 days of taking the hands-on course.**

Refresher for certificate holder:

Holders of existing International Offshore Safety at Sea with hands-on training Certificates (*not* an Offshore Certificate) less than 7 years old, may attend a Refresher Safety at Sea hands-on ONLY (1-day) course. This certificate has a World Sailing logo on the left side. Below is how it reads on the certificate.

Has Completed a US Sailing Sanctioned
**INTERNATIONAL OFFSHORE SAFETY AT SEA
COURSE WITH HANDS-ON TRAINING**

You **must** take Online Safety at Sea: Offshore Upgrade (units 11 – 15) before attending the Hands-on Training **ONLY** (1-day) refresher course. Upon completion of hands-on training and verification of the completion of the online course, US Sailing will issue you an International Offshore Safety at Sea certificate.

It is the **responsibility** of the Host Organizer to verify the attendee's certifications,
