



# Conditions for the US Wingfoil Championship

## SECTION A PREAMBLE

*Section A clauses do not rank as “rules” as defined by the Racing Rules of Sailing. As such, boats in a regatta may not protest each other for failure to comply with this preamble, nor base a request for redress on the alleged failure of an organizing authority, race committee, protest committee or technical committee to obey the clauses of this preamble.*

### A1 INTRODUCTION

- A1.1 These conditions govern the US Wingfoil Championship (Championship).
- A1.2 This championship is governed by these conditions and the US Sailing Championships Conditions (abbreviated below as “overall conditions”).

## SECTION B CHAMPIONSHIP RULES

*Section B clauses DO rank as ‘rules’ as defined by the Racing Rules of Sailing.*

*The notation ‘[DP]’ in a rule of this section means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification. The notation ‘[NP]’ in a rule of this section means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule nor request redress based on that rule. This changes RRS 60.1 and 61.1.*

### B1 GOVERNANCE

- B1.1 See the overall conditions for additional conditions that apply.

### B2 ELIGIBILITY AND SELECTION OF TEAMS

- B2.1 International competitors who meet the eligibility requirements are welcome to participate; however, they will not be eligible to win the title or trophy.

### B3 BOAT/EQUIPMENT

- B3.1 The event will be sailed in WingFoil class boards. Competitors are responsible for providing their own equipment.
- B3.2 The WingFoil Open Class Rules will apply.
- B3.3 The current version of the World Sailing Development Rule Appendix WF ‘Wingfoiling Racing Rules’ shall apply (<https://www.sailing.org/tools/documents/DR2105AppendixWFWingfoilingRacingrulesJune2021-%5B27358%5D.pdf>)

### B4 COACHING AND SUPPORT BOATS

- B4.1 Unless changed by the notice of race, the coaching level will be Grade 3 (no private coaching) in accordance with the US Sailing Coaching and Support Boat Policy.

## SECTION C CHAMPIONSHIP POLICIES

As such, boats in a regatta may not protest each other for failure to comply with this preamble, nor base a request for redress on the alleged failure of an organizing authority, race committee, protest committee or technical committee to obey the clauses of this preamble.*

## **C1 SCORING**

- C1.1 The Low Point Scoring System (RRS Appendix A) will be used. The sailing instructions will state the criteria for excluded races.
- C1.2 A minimum of 1 completed race is necessary to constitute a championship.

## **C2 PRIZES**

- C2.1 Medals for 1 - 3 place overall will be provided.
- C2.2 More prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the OA and the host club.
