

## SMALL BOAT SAILING INSTRUCTOR CERTIFICATION COURSE HOST FACILITY REQUIREMENTS

Thank you for offering to host a US Sailing Small Boat Course! Below are the requirements for host facilities. ## **BOATS AND EQUIPMENT**

- Sailboats, single or double-handed dinghies, with tillers and tiller extensions; enough for 8-12 people
  - Sailing Counselor Instructor at least one capsizeable boat
  - Small Boat Level 1 Instructor at least one capsizeable boat
  - o Small Boat Level 2 Instructor dinghies with spinnaker and trapeze setup, at least one capsizeable boat
  - o Small Boat Level 3 Coach at least one capsizeable boat
- Safety Boat
  - One to two boats, preferably:
    - Small, low-freeboard, outboard engine
    - Working Engine Cut-Off Switch (ECOS) must be tethered, not wireless
    - Current registration (per the State and USCG requirements)
    - First Aid Supplies for Safety Boat(s) and all USCG required equipment
    - Anchor and anchor line
    - VHF Radio one per boat
- Small marks with ground tackle ideally 4 to 6 marks
- Line three (3) lengths of six (6) foot line

## **ON-SHORE FACILITIES**

- Dedicated, well-lit and ventilated classroom with adequate tables and chairs
- Classroom and boats are to be no more than a 10-minute walk apart
- Whiteboard/Chalkboard with dry erase markers/chalk in three (3) colors
- Appropriate location for water comfort check
- Restrooms (showers if possible)

## PRE-COURSE PREPARATION

- Provide Instructor Trainer with a copy of Emergency Procedures for site location
- Ensure all equipment is in good and working condition daily (including but not limited to sails, lines, blades, safety boats, etc.)
- Prepare safety boat(s) each day (gas, anchor, small marks, and ground tackle)
- Adequate insurance coverage
